Interfor Corporation and NACFOR
2021 Aerial Forest Fertilization



Please be advised that in partnership with the Ministry of Forest, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development Forest Carbon Initiative (FCI) program, Interfor Corporation and Nakusp and Area Community Forest (NACFOR) are delivering an aerial forest fertilization project for selected sites on TFL 23, Forest Licence A20192 and Community Forest Agreement K2S in the Selkirk Forest District. Funding for this project is delivered through the Land Base Investment Forests For Tomorrow (FFT) program.

Fertilization treatment objectives are to increase tree volume for carbon sequestration. For more information of the BC Provincial Government Forest Fertilization program go to <https://tinyurl.com/5d3n8cwn>

The fertilization project will be based out of Interfor's Castlegar Woodlands Nakusp office. The treatment areas encompass three geographic locations: the west side of Arrow Lake from Fosthall Creek to Arrow Park; Woden Creek south-east of Burton; and McDonald Creek 15 km south of Nakusp on Highway 6 West. Approximately 6,000 hectares will be treated with aerial application of urea-based fertilizer. Aerial fertilization operations are planned for September 23 to October 31, 2021.
